The band began as the project of guitarist Aggelos Tzamtzis, who moved to Berlin to realize his dream. He soon brought in Tim Crawford (guitar and backing vocals) and Felipe Melo Villarroel (drums). But almost immediately, Covid-19 hit and they found themselves in lockdown and unable to jam again until restrictions lifted. However, they wasted no time in finding a home studio in a “crazy historic building in Berlin” and brought in Tallon Smith (vocals) and Vangelis Sazanides (bass) to complete the lineup.

The result was Threads’ debut EP “**Akasha**”, which was recorded in **KAOS Studios**, Berlin. Mixed and mastered by Aggelos Tzamtzis and Frankie Insulina. The EP was finally released in June 2021 and is available on every digital platform. A visualiser video for the first single ‘**Tessera**’ was also produced and is available on YouTube.

Threads’ sound has been influenced by a wide range of progressive rock and metal bands as Porcupine Tree, The Ocean, Thrice, Deftones, Tool, Alcest, Cult of Luna, Gojira, and Opeth.

Continuing with the same enthusiasm, the band has just released their first video clip based on the song “Colorless”, which is also present on the EP. According to the band, this song is significant since it not only closes a cycle but also opens a new one. Says Aggelos “This song was written for a band I had in the past (Berehynia) and it was the one that helped me find the members of Threads, plus it was the first one we played as a fully formed band, so we think it’s very representative for us”.

The theme of loneliness emerges from the song, which is the main topic. This is why it is referred to by showing the dancer alone as well as all the members of the band, who only meet at the end to close the video.

Within the making of the video, we had the opportunity to work with great people but we must undoubtedly thank mainly Sandy (camera) and Nolwenn (dancer). They did an exceptional job and that is reflected in the final result.

Now with the EP already released, the band is working on a new album that will be available in 2022. In the meantime, a video clip for the second single ‘**Colorless**’ has already been filmed and will be out in November.

“We’re just at the start of our musical journey but we’re really excited about where it’s gonna take us. Watch this space!”
