CLUSTERHEAD is a 4 piece metal band, hailing from Regensburg, Germany. After its foundation in 2005 the band released 3 demos. On May 30th 2008 they released their debut album "Times Of No Trust" through German label Artist Service/Music Buy Mail.

CLUSTERHEAD's sound is featuring powerful riffs, a strong rhythm section, hook-laden but unique melodies and distinctive vocals, performed by throughout experienced musicians who don't try to follow any current trends. They just want to deliver what they have been influenced by in their youth and what many metal fans are searching for: pinpoint metal power, mighty melodies, big vocals, wrapped into modern sound and an up-to-date production.

CLUSTERHEAD also gained comprehensive live experience by continously playing regional and national venues. In spring 2008 they proved to be an awesome support band by opening for US power metal heroes CAGE in southern Germany and thus surely could add lots of new fans to their constantly growing fanbase.

CLUSTERHEAD's live shows are energetic and powerful whereat vocalist René proves to be the leader of the pack, constantly incorporating the audience and relentlessly giving his best to entertain the masses. Frank's heavy but always melodic riffing dominates the band's sound and is built upon a strong, machine-like working rhythm section, led by drummer Rud and bassist Andy

CLUSTERHEAD shows are not limited just to fans of the melodic metal genre. You will find a very diverse audience at their gigs, ranging from old-school heavy metal fans to lovers of harder and more modern stuff.

CLUSTERHEAD "Times Of No Trust" enre: Melodic Metal Artist Service



Previous EP material has seen journalists compare Clusterhead to Bonfire, Axel Rudi Pell, Pink Cream 69 and a number of their other genre heroes and, from the off, the influences aboard "Times Are No Trust" are obvious. Songs like the powerful "Poisoned", "Deep In The Night" and "Made Of Stone" stand out while their

handling of the classic balled format on "Ghosts" is more than accomplished. One major plus in the Clusterhead arsenal is the guitar prowess of Frank Stadlbaeur. Throughout the album, the classic metal riffs of Stadibaeur scream loudest and, when the band's sound starts to waiver, it is his guitar work that ultimately

keeps the listener interested.

Clusterhead are a metal act for fans of classic riffs.

They've obviously dined on a diet of Scorpions, Iron Maiden, Iney ve obviously dined on a diet of scorpions, from Maiden, Judas Priest et al and the product of this strong musical upbringing is an accomplished European metal record. Unfortunately it is far from a flawless release. The peaks and troughs aboard "Times Of No Trust" are stark and although I applaud the band when they're on top, there are ultimately too many times where I'm left indifferent to their music. The band locker is packed with talent, but I just don't feel they hit the ground running on this album
