Remarks about the keyboard setup

- * We need at least 3 separate channels for a mono-mix of keyboards and backing tracks. For a stereo-mix, which we highly recommend, we need 5 separate channels.
- * Each channel has a balanced XLR, so we don't require any DI's
- * The XLR-cables on the audio interface are 6m long. Please make sure the PA or multi-cable is within this reach, if not please provide us with additional cables (3 or 5, depending on the mono or stereo setup).
- * The drummer's in-ear kit is also connected to the keyboard setup. If the keyboards can't be set up within 6m of the drum kit, please provide is with TWO additional XLR cables

Monitoring

- Separate monitor mixes for all band members if possible.
- Dedicated monitor for the drummer
- Keyboard player has in-ear monitoring, so no separate monitor required
