Equipment that we have:

Equipment that we need from your team on the stage:

Equipment	Amount
PA-System (Loudspeakers and mixer)	1
Floor Monitors	1
Chairs (Minimum 1 chair for drummer)	1
Microphone+Microphone Stand	



Notes:

- 1. PA system with a 6.3mm input and home mixer is very important to be provided on the stage. Normally, our band would set up our sound by connecting all of our instruments (microphone, e-guitar, e-bass, e-drum, keyboard, etc) and our in-ear system to our small mixer by using XLR cables (for microphones) and TS instrument cables (for guitar, bass, e-drum, keyboard). Then we connect our 6.3mm outputs of the small mixer (left and right outputs) with a 6m TRS Cable to the home mixer. Then the home mixer will be then connected to the PA System.
- 2. E-Guitar amplifier and E-Bass amplifier are not that necessary but would be much better if they are there. But if we are using an E-Guitar Amplifier and E-Bass Amplifier, then the sound setup will be a little bit different. Because we need DI Box-es for both E-Guitar and E-Bass and extra XLR Cables (minimum 2 XLR Cables) to connect both of the DI Box-es to the mixer. (This is not necessary if note number 1 is accomplished).
- 3. **Drumset** will be much better if you can provide it for us. A real drumset will, of course, sound much better than an **E-drum**. But it is not necessary. If you cannot provide it, we are going to go with note **number 1**.
- 4. Extra microphones and microphone stands are not necessary but better if they are provided on the stage.
- 5. Chairs for our drummer ist necessary.
- 6. Floor monitor is necessary provided by the event organizer.
- 7. Extra instrument cables and XLR cables would be better too if provided by the event organizer.
- 8. If there are any sound technicians from your team with a better sound setup and better equipment setup, we will be very happy to follow their procedure.
