

Martin Tetzlaff stands for Berlin-Indie-Lo-Fi Handcraft.

His sound ranges from epochal power pop sound walls to well thought out electronic compositions and sublime post rock hymns over to small folk songs with no lack of affectionate acoustics.

Where huge labels are desperately looking for images for their acts, the native Berliner is a pleasantly strange guy who unabashedly publishes his music.

His annual 'The Sensational Martin Tetzlaff Birthday Singer-Songwriter Show Night' attracts several hundred music enthusiasts who admire what the people catcher puts on stage.

The songwriter from Neukölln has an eventful history to look back on: he left his marks

flying solo as well as part of the post punk band About Blake and shared the stage with greats like Tiger Lou, The Frank and Walters, Louis Eliot from the Brit-Pop legends Rialto, Sven van Thom, Sometree, Kat Frankie or Kitty Solaris. He created music with the producers of Franz Ferdinand, Element of Crime and Blumfeld and worked with parts of the Berlin Sonar Kollektiv.

His third LP 'Hideaway' will be published in November 2023. 10 songs about the turmoil of interpersonal affairs, longing for love and distance and the never ending search for an internal palace of refuge. 'Hideaway' combines post punk, electro pop, eurodance and singer- songwriter songs into a monolith set to music.
