For Vocals:
Shure SM58 (or Shure Super 55 Deluxe if available) into
Vocal FX (external or in mixer)
Into mixer
FX: Big Reverb and slapback Echo/Delay, doubling if available
For Synth & Drum Machine:
Roland MC-101 w/ two mono 1/4" outs (L and R, Klinke)
Into mixer

For Guitar:
ESP Baritone Guitar into
Headrush MX5 Multi-FX & Cabsim pedal
Into mixer

Ilia (Vox/Bass) uses:
For Vocals:
Shure SM58 into
Zoom V3 Vocal Processor
Into mixer
For Bass:
Bass Guitar (usually Squire P-Bass) into
Line6 HX Stomp FX & Amp Sim
Into mixer ( & into bass amp if available)
Info for Engineer:
The entire setup works on a DI/ampless basis, though we'll gladly add a bass amp to the setup if the PA alone is not enough to "push" FOH.
Mix should prioritise Vocals and MC-101.
Low frequencies (approx. 30-150hz) are handled by Drum Machine and Synths on most songs - the bass guitar fills out the low mid range and gets a low cut as to not

We appreciate a warm overall mix, a high cut/LPF might be required on the MC-101

to reduce harshness (depending on the room & system).
