chronobio

The band project "HoloTropicTrancePunx" evolved round the turn of the century into a psychedelic crossover songfactory they built with the tRaumstation studio at RAW-tempel in Berlin. Their extraordinary and diversified song material centered around Frank Oz' compositions and the vocals of the sisters Mikado and Joushi. Even in this early stage they were prone to cross over genre borders and musical collaborations.

2007 they started with a fresh cast as Prunx. Engaging Da Crap on drums and Stilgar on bass they celebrated the take off into new dimensions with the Berlin based bands Alice Daisy, Mamasweed and Mosquito Control at KATO, Berlin.

End of the year 2008 they published the album Blameshifter as CD and on bandcamp with a Berlin-New York underground double release party with Lucibel Crater from Brooklyn.

2009 they experienced the first crash landing. DaCrap became seriously ill and the band parted for the time being. DaCrap left the planet in July 2010, his music stays unforgotten! To keep it that way, PrunX decided to produce a tribute album, asked all good drummers being around and recorded seven songs with Zam Johnson, Lothar Jonas, Dremma, Ben und Mark Gotye. Because there was no budget, all songs were recorded live in one studio day! They presented the resulting album 5 of 6 in 2011 at Theaterkapelle Berlin.

In the following years the band kept on flying. With Quadrum on drums in 2014 they collaborated with the Berlin video platform Open Stage Berlin, realising a live video for Devil's Cookbook. They created Earth cries with Stefan Gorke on drums and video art by Stilgar, who as well designed a song video for Jungle Rumble. Earth cries was prereleased on the double CD feature Songs für den Frieden Vol. 02, the videoclip on new years eve 2015. To find an adequate and longterm drummer took until the beginning of 2016. Ever since Mr. X handles the FTL drive. Less concerts but more studio work on new material happened, beside others in collaboration with N.U. Unruh.

PrunX performed first live sets with Mr. X with Dirty Feetz, Berlin and Jesse Cannonball Statman and Mallory Feuer from Brooklyn. More studio work and videoshooting for new releases as well as refreshing their web presentation had priority in 2017. They released vol. III as digital EP on German Shepherd Records on June 19th, which was followed by Mind Trajectory Nov 3th, presented live Nov 9th at Urban Spree Berlin, as well presenting a limited edition of both EPs on CD. Clips for Sick of it all and Iron Dream accompanied the production, the latter sarcastically released on German reunion day and screened at Boddinale Berlin in February 2018.

Unfortunately, **PrunX** crossed a black hole over the turn of the year and could no longer maintain communication with *Stilgar* on foreign mission. However, the crew is surrounded by experienced bass operators *Mr*. *Y* and the rescue mission seems to be successful. The concert at *Backdoor Party* in March with operator *Berny* produced the live clip **Dirty Gods**, followed by **Maze live** in summer 2018. The next EP will be released on *GSR* in the end of **2018**, meanwhile they are working on a concept album of greater length, and may contain a song of it for prelistening.
